Prayer changes things. And this year, we believe God is calling us to something powerful.

For the **first time**, thousands of Christians across our community are spreading out into their neighborhoods on the **National Day of Prayer** – not gathering in one place, but scattering into hundreds of homes, streets, and front yards to pray right where they live.

Your front yard becomes a Prayer Spot. Your street becomes holy ground. And together, we become a visible, prayerful presence for our entire city – a movement of ordinary people doing an extraordinary thing.

This is how the church shines. This is **how we love our neighbors**. This is our moment.

WHAT YOU NEED TO DO

STEP 1 | Pick Up Your Kit & Register

- Kits are available 1–3 weeks before May 7 at all participating churches.
- Your kit includes this guide and 10 Neighbor Prayer Cards.
- Make sure to register as a Prayer Spot – we want to celebrate every home standing in prayer across our community! We will use this to build a map showing every Prayer Spot. If you have not done that yet, please do so now using the QR code on the back.

STEP 2 | Hand Out Neighbor Prayer Cards

- Deliver your cards to neighbors 1–2 weeks before May 7. This is one of the most natural, low-pressure opportunities you will have all year to knock on a door, introduce yourself, and let your neighbor know you care.
- No agenda, no pressure – just a card, a kind word, and an offer to pray. Don't underestimate how powerful this moment can be.
- A simple conversation on a doorstep can open a door that changes everything. And who knows – your neighbor may have been waiting for someone to show up just like this.

STEP 3 | Put Out Your Yard Sign

- Your yard sign marks your home as a Prayer Spot and invites neighbors to join you or scan the QR code to share a prayer request. It's a small act that makes a statement.
- Put out 1-2 weeks before, or by May 3rd at the latest.
- Yard signs available while supplies last.

STEP 4 | Pray on May 7th

- Step outside and pray. We suggest 6:00 or 7:00 PM, but any time works.
- Pray alone, with your family, or with whoever shows up.
- Pray for your neighbors, your street, your city, your country, and the world.
- Know you are not praying alone – thousands of others around the nation and our community are standing with you in prayer.

STEP 5 | Share What God Did

- We want to celebrate with everyone who participated. Go to www.churchesforthecity.com and share any stories, photos, and moments from the day.
- Do it right away, within 24hrs of NDP.
- Let's celebrate together what God did when His people prayed.
